Courçay is a town situated in the Indre-et-Loire departement (Centre region) The town of de Courçay belongs to the canton of de Bléré and the district of de Tours. The inhabitants of de Courçay are called Courciquois and their number in the 1999 population census was 694. The town's surface is 25.1 km². Courçay has the following INSEE code: 37085 and is associated with the following postal code : 37310. It is situated at an altitude of about 70 meters.

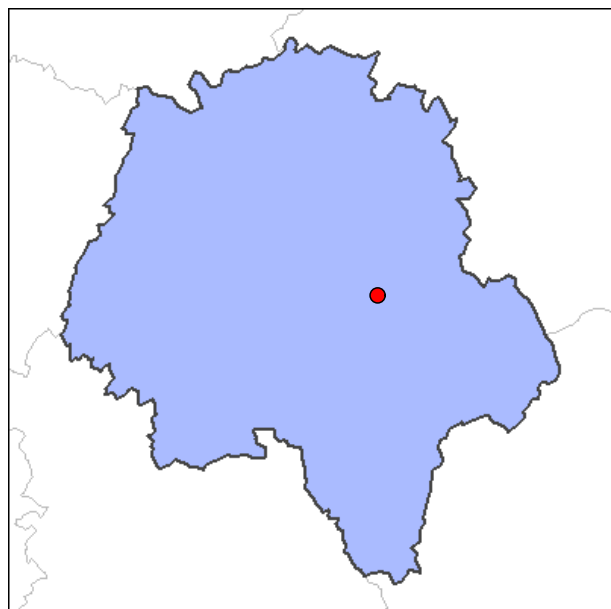
