

Pont-Hébert

Pont-Hébert is a town situated in the Manche departement (Basse-Normandie region) The town of de Pont-Hébert belongs to the canton of de Saint-Jean-de-Daye and the district of de Saint-Lô. The inhabitants of de Pont-Hébert are called Pontois and their number in the 1999 population census was 1713. The town's surface is 15.4 km². Pont-Hébert has the following INSEE code: 50409 and is associated with the following postal code : 50880. It is situated at an altitude of about 30 meters.

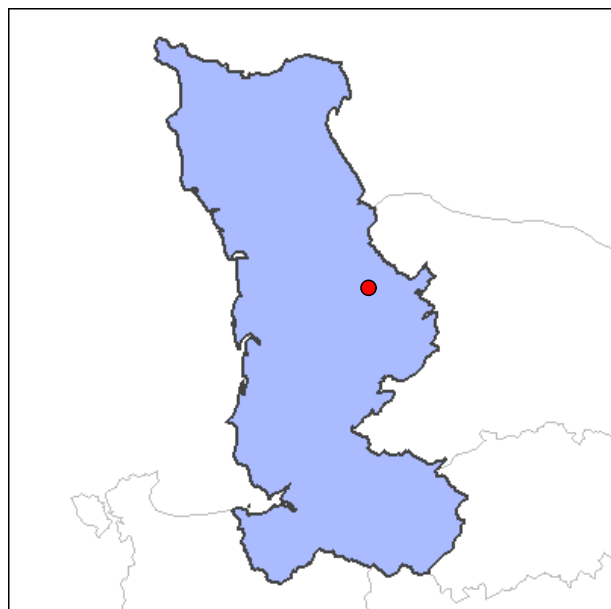
